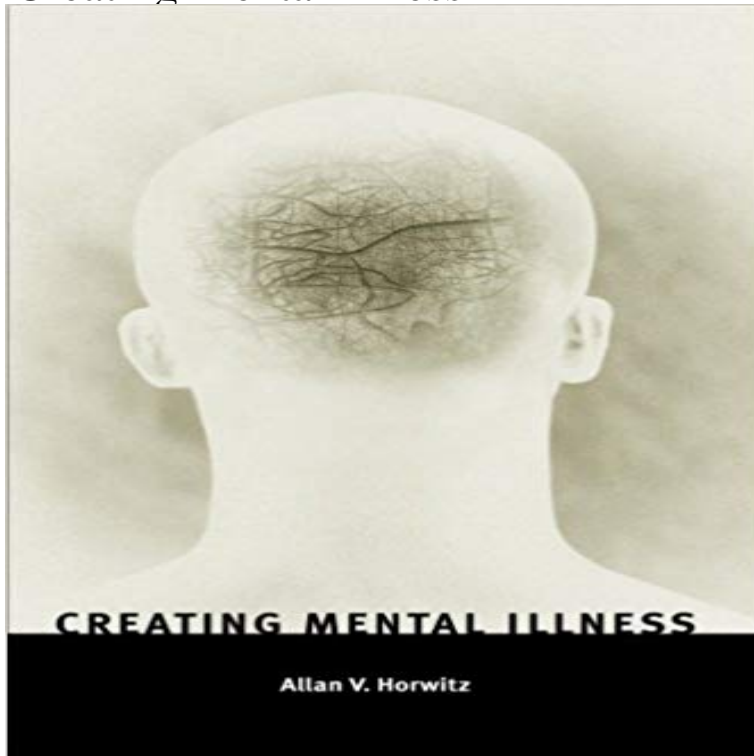


Creating Mental Illness
