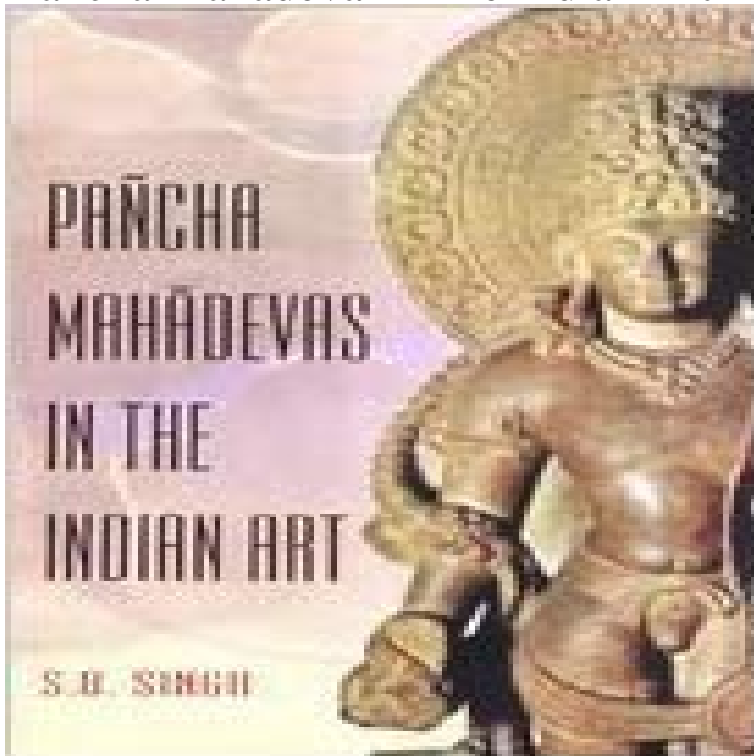


Pancha Mahadeva In The Indian Art
