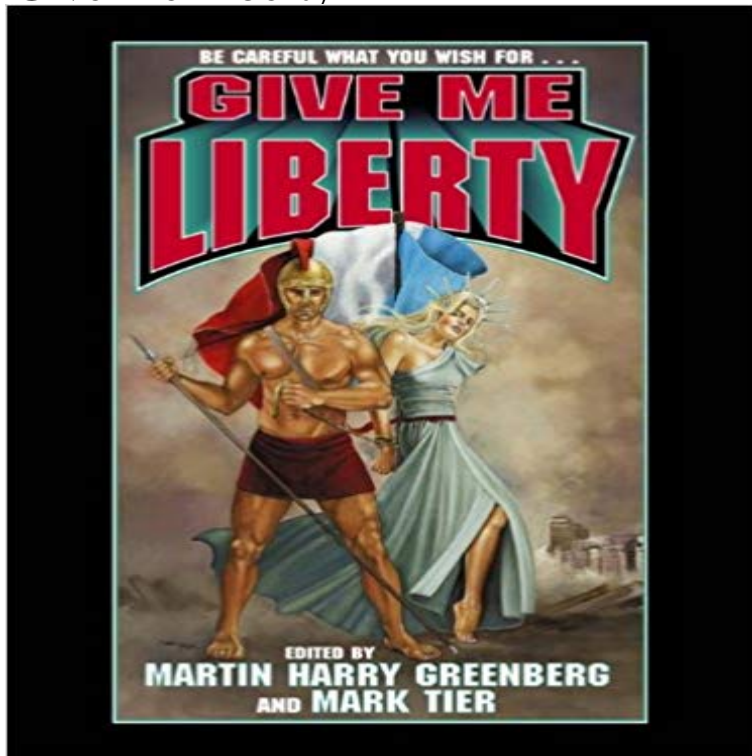


Give Me Liberty
