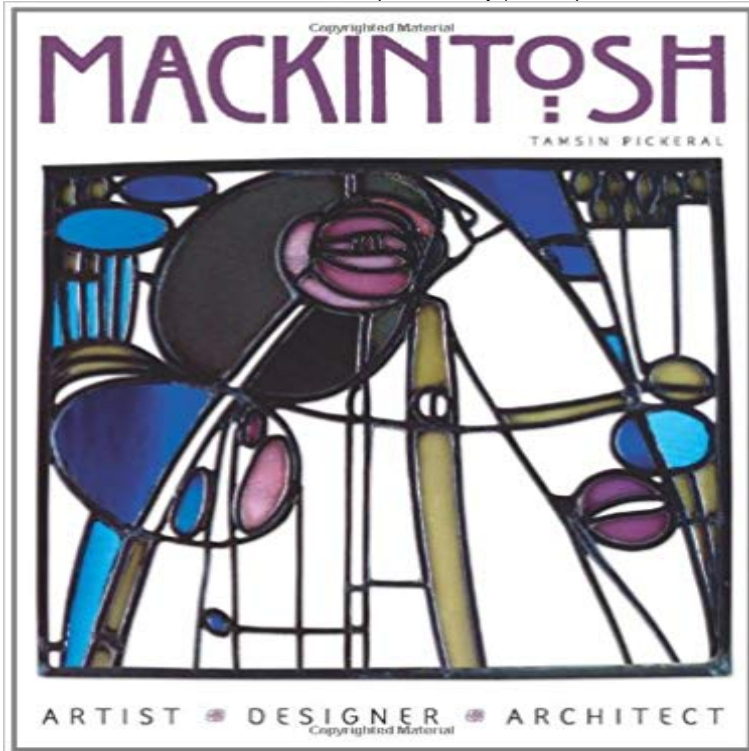


Mackintosh: Artist, Designer, Architect
