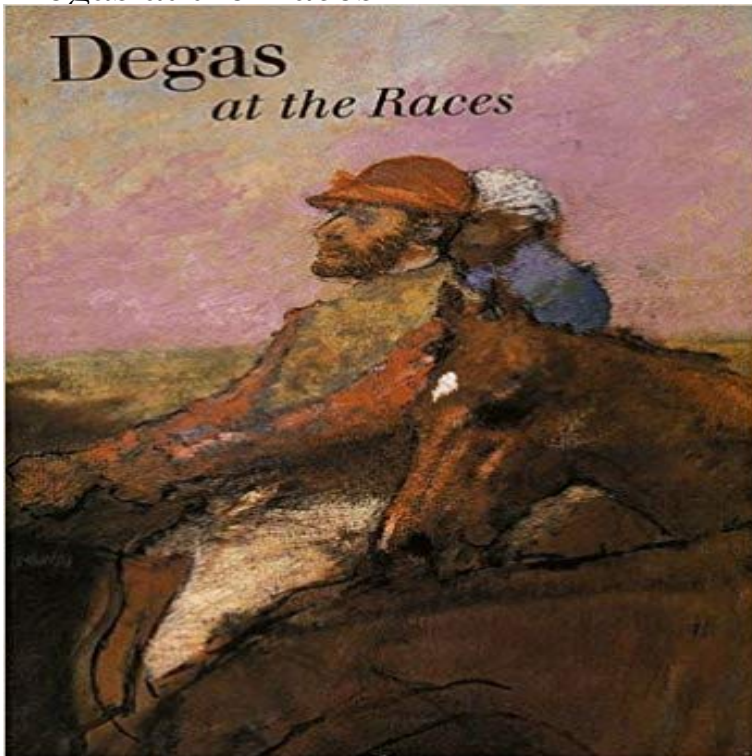


Degas at the Races
