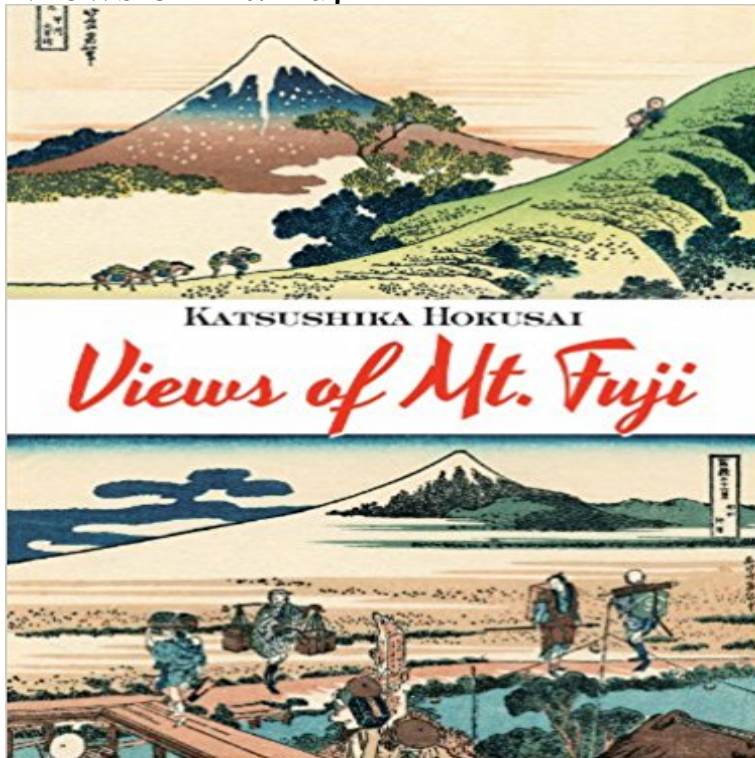


Views of Mt. Fuji
