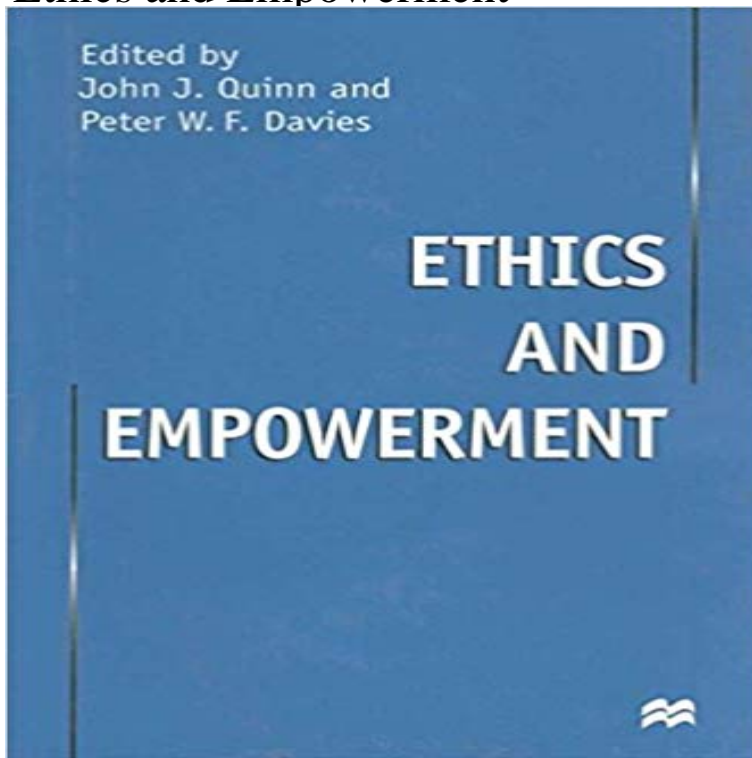


Ethics and Empowerment
