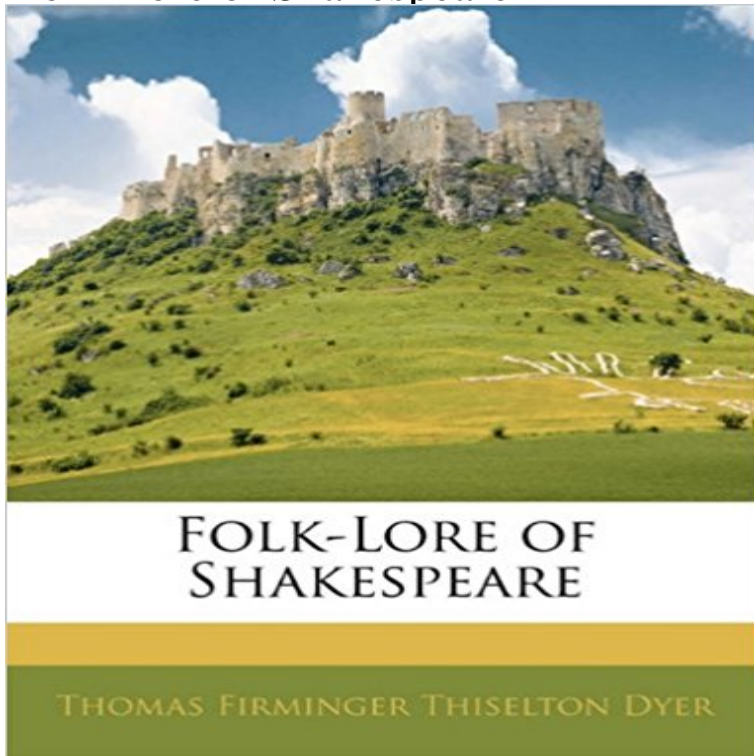


Folk-Lore of Shakespeare
