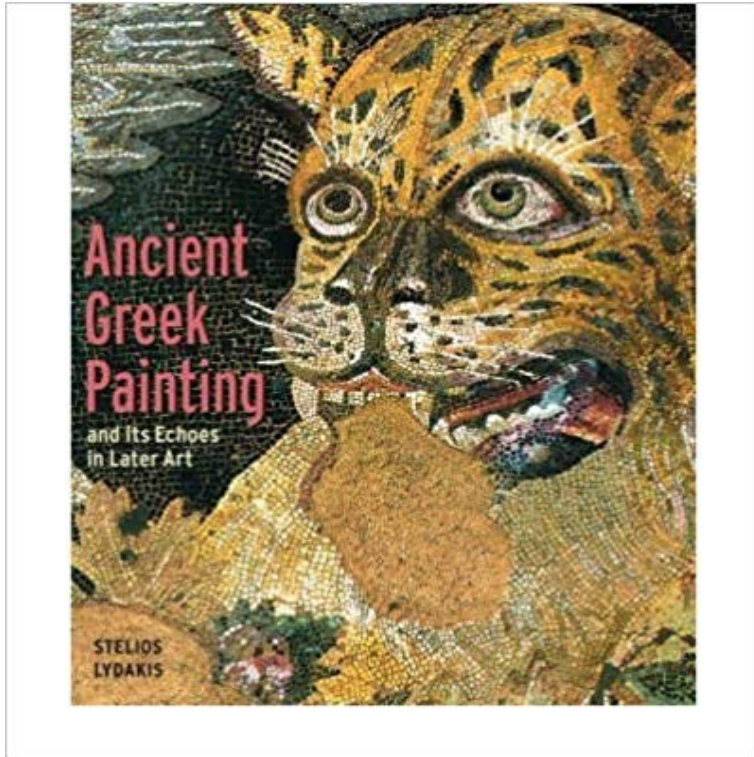


Ancient Greek Painting and Its Echoes in Later Art (Hardback) - Common
