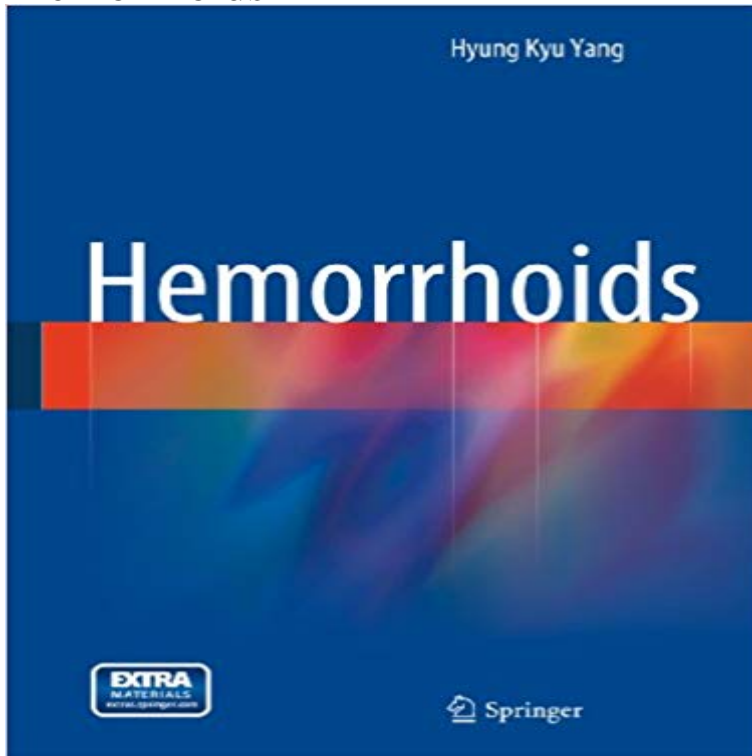


Hemorrhoids
