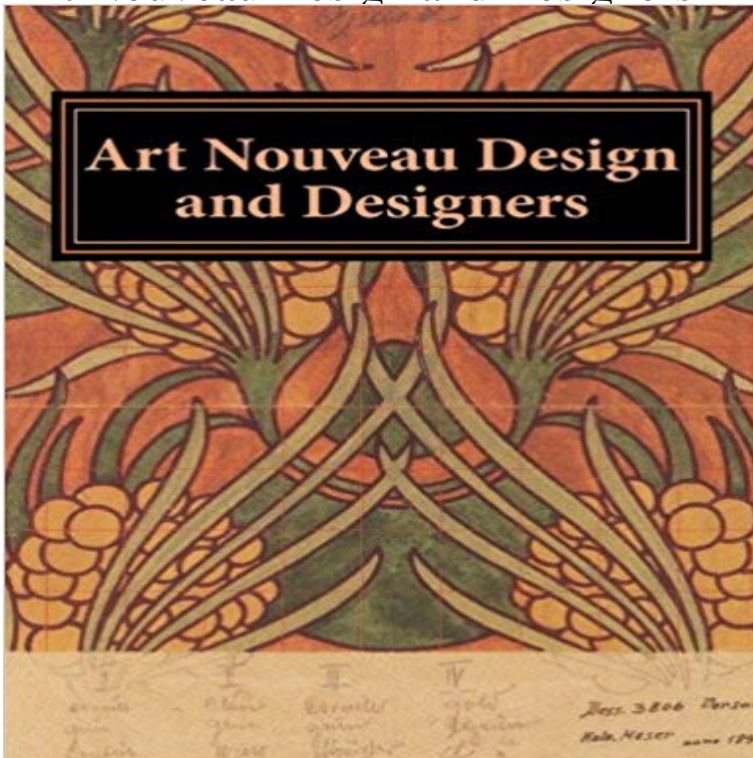


## Art Nouveau Design and Designers
