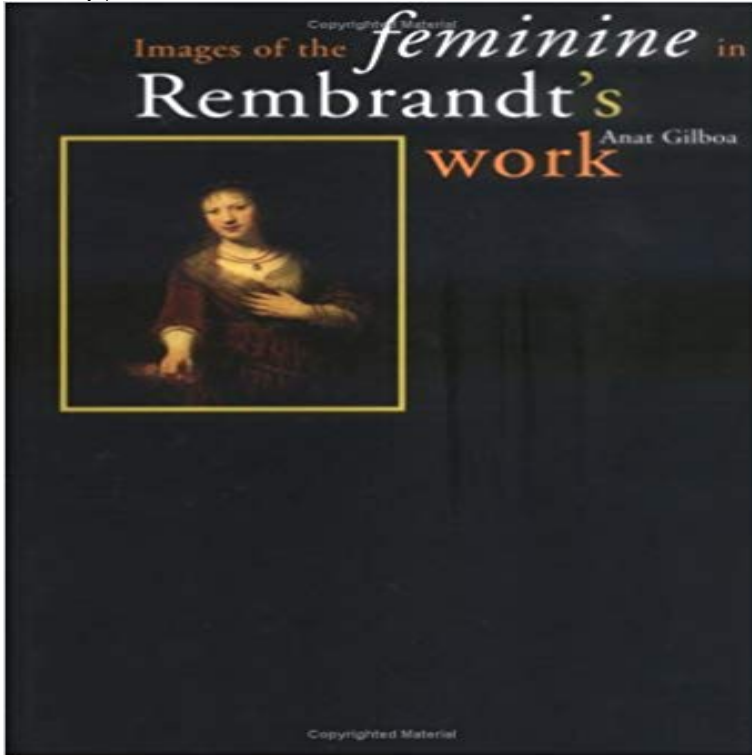


Images of the Feminine in Rembrandts Work
