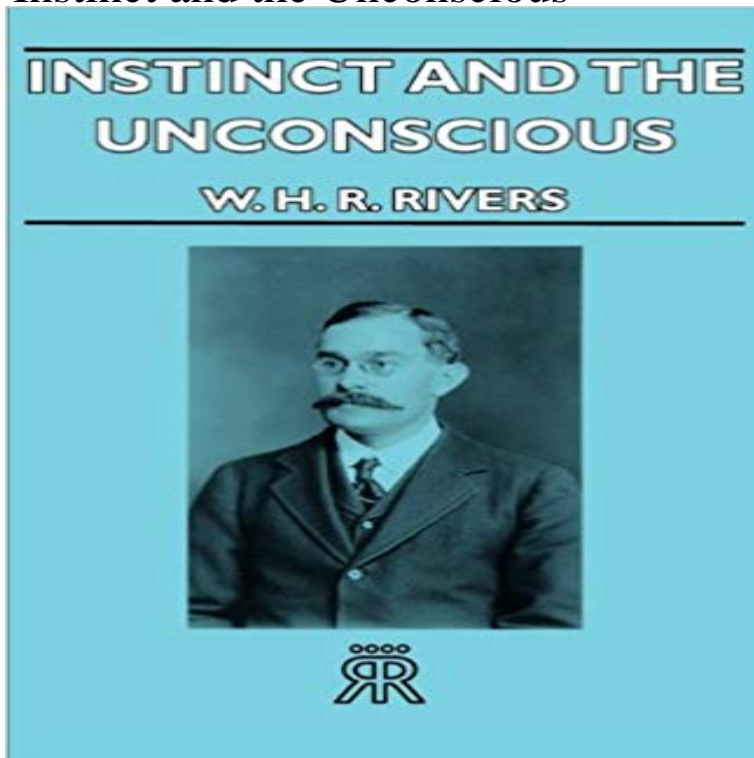


Instinct and the Unconscious
