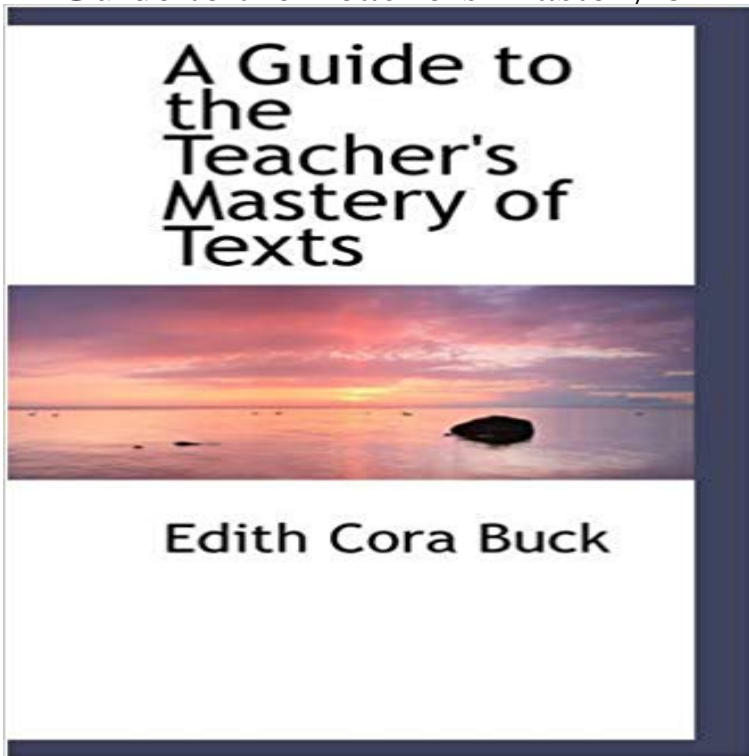


A Guide to the Teachers Mastery of Texts
