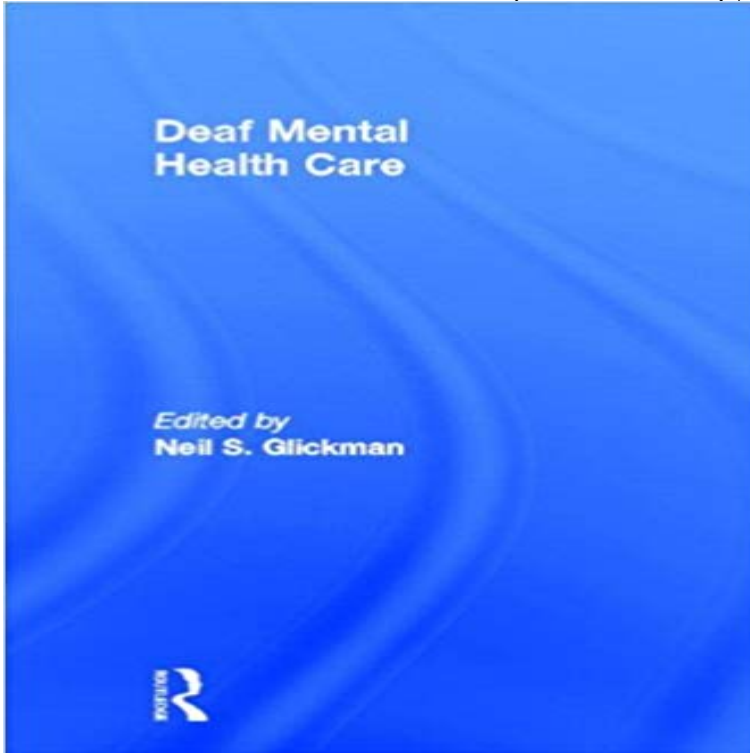


Deaf Mental Health Care (Counseling and Psychotherapy)
