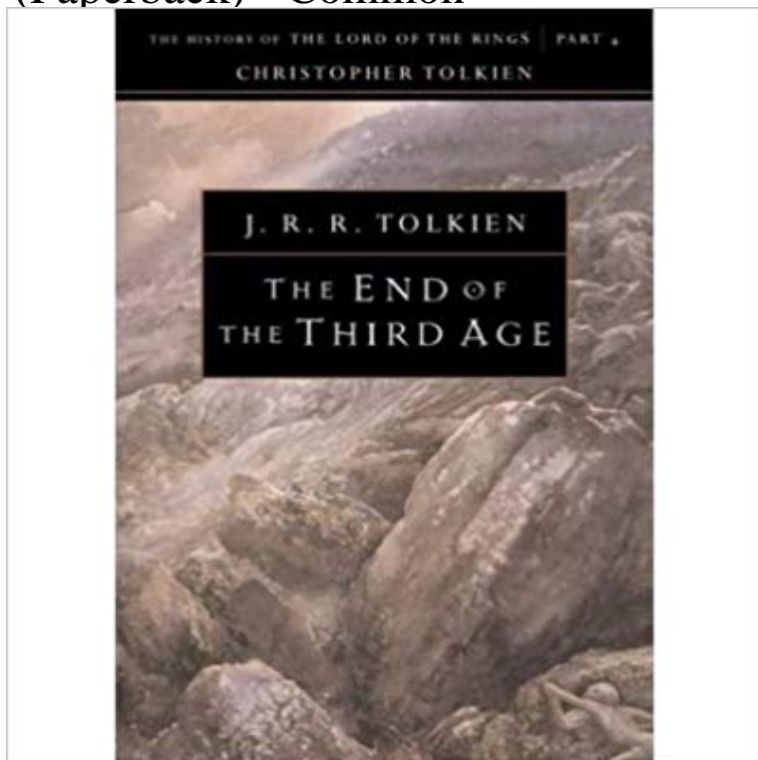


The End of the Third Age (The History of the Lord of the Rings, Part 4) (Paperback) - Common
