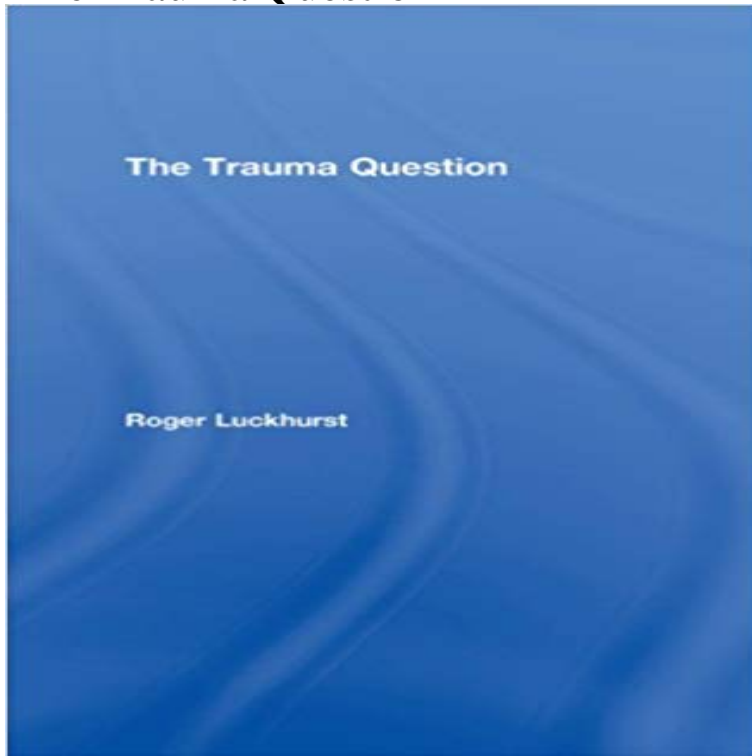


The Trauma Question
