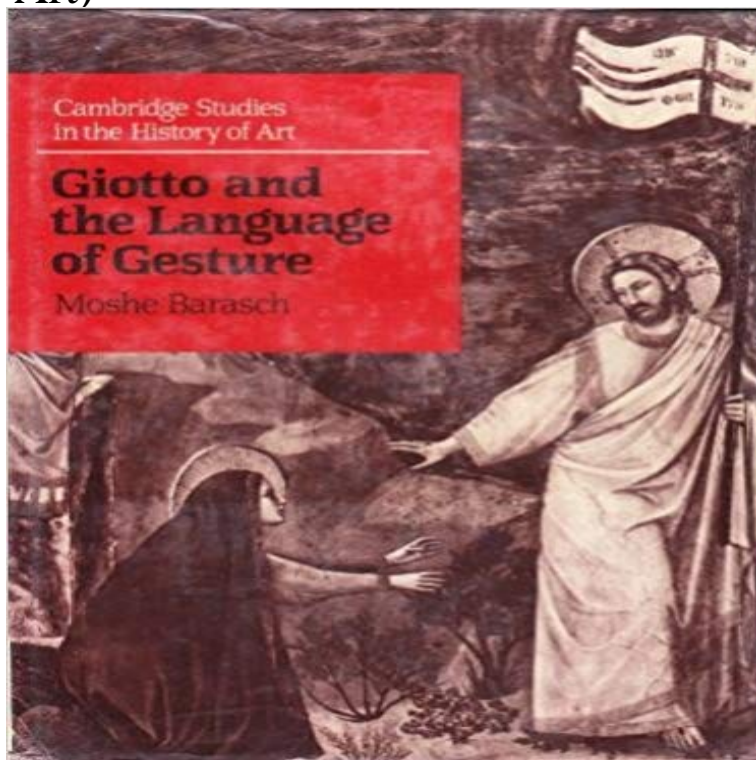


Giotto and the Language of Gesture (Cambridge Studies in the History of Art)
