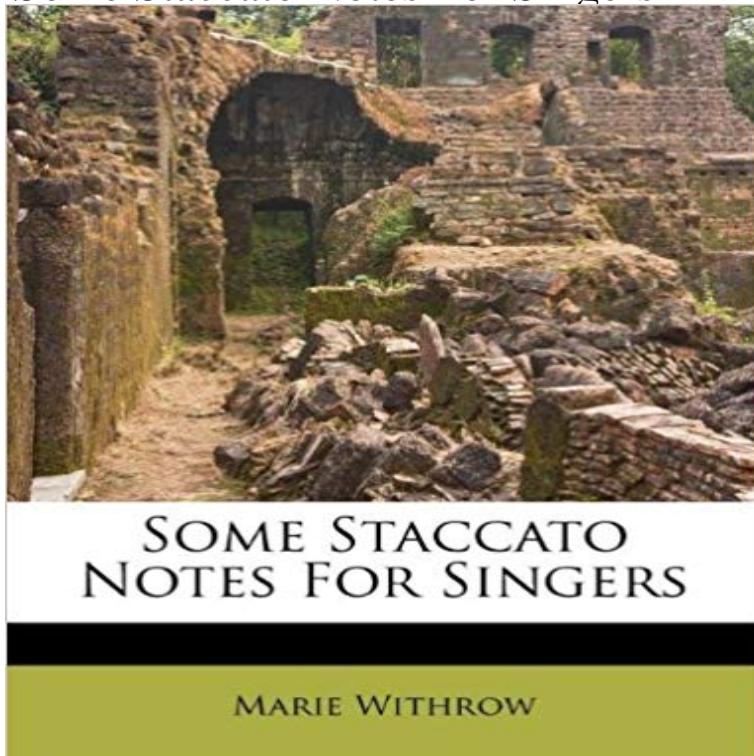


Some Staccato Notes For Singers
