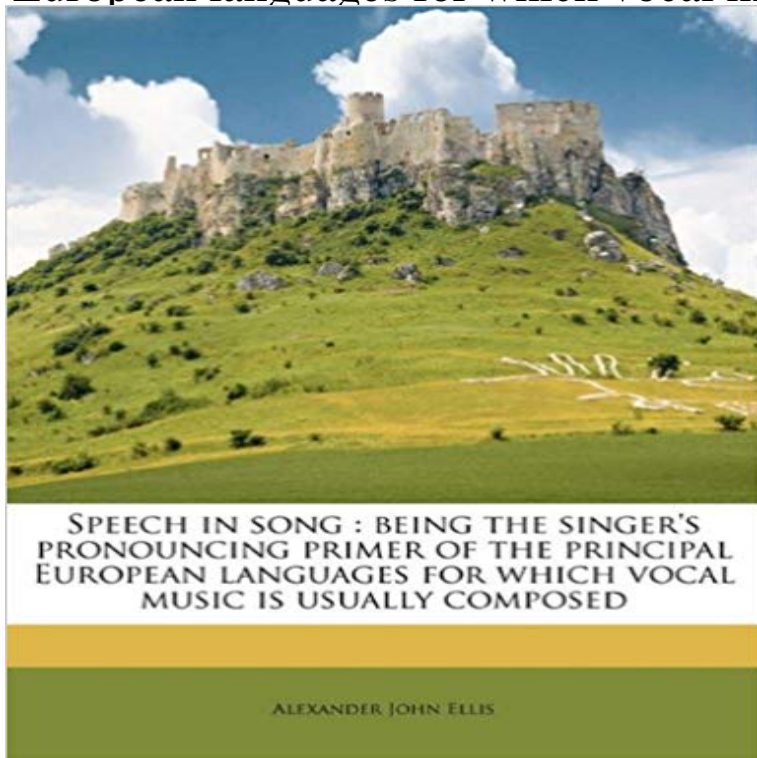


Speech in song: being the singers pronouncing primer of the principal European languages for which vocal music is usually composed
