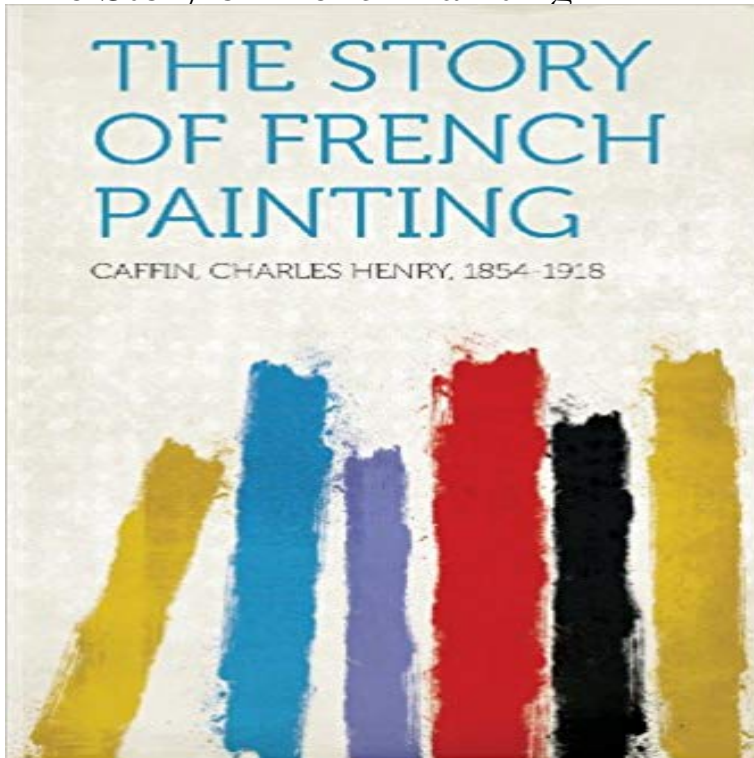


The Story of French Painting
