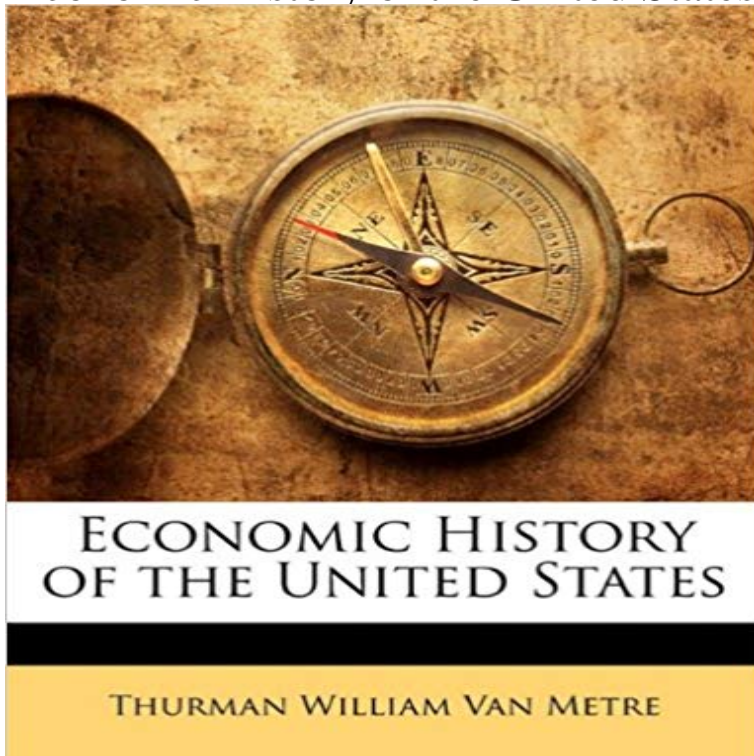


Economic History of the United States
