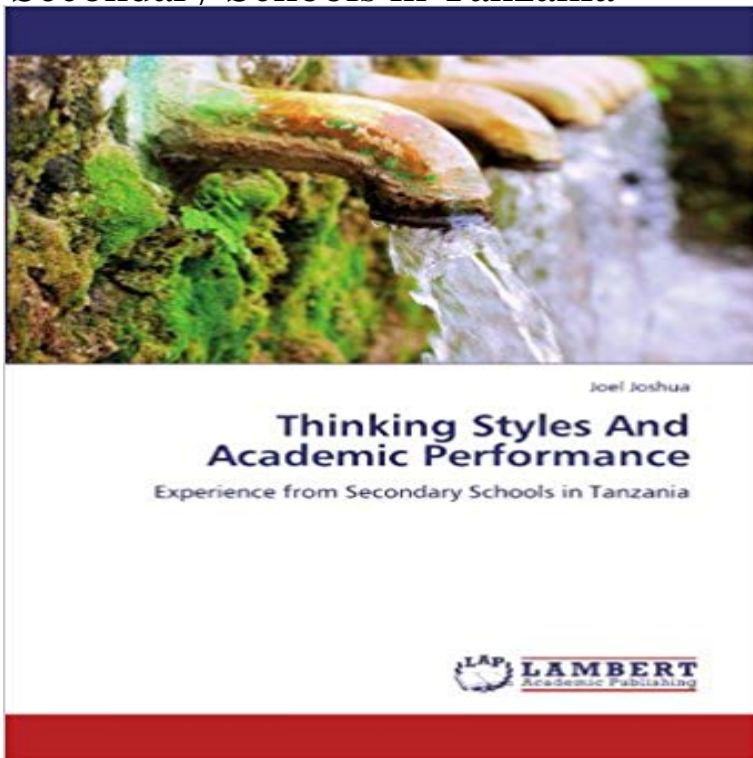


Thinking Styles And Academic Performance: Experience from Secondary Schools in Tanzania
