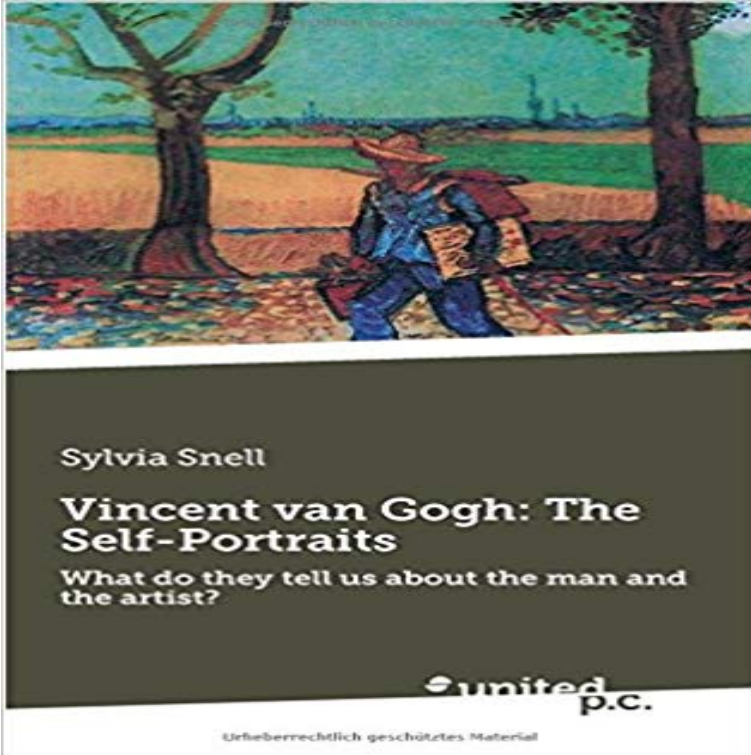


Vincent van Gogh: The Self-Portraits: What do they tell us about the man and the artist?
