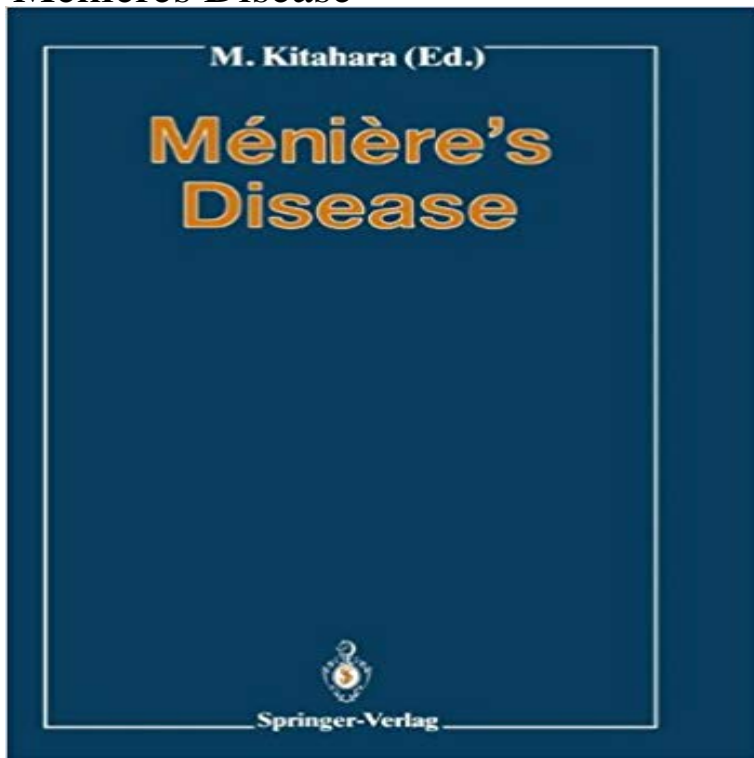


Menieres Disease
